



## NOTES

1. Member Email addresses will only be used for sending relevant information on behalf of the Club and will not be shared with Third Parties.
2. Badminton subscription includes the provision of shuttlecocks.
3. Tennis subscription includes the use of Floodlights as and when required.
4. New Tennis members please note: To be recognised by the LTA, it is necessary to become British Tennis members. Go to [www.lta.org.uk/member/](http://www.lta.org.uk/member/) for details.

5. It is to be distinctly understood that any person over 16 must become a senior Club member before being admitted to any Section as vacancies occur.
6. No person under the age of 16 (juniors) can be accepted for senior Club membership. However, they can apply for junior membership of tennis, bowls or badminton (using the appropriate Section junior membership application form).
7. The intermediate subscription applies to persons aged 16 and 17 on 1<sup>st</sup> January, or date of payment of subscription, in any year. It also applies to persons aged 18 or over, but under 21 on the 1<sup>st</sup> January in any year, provided they are in full time education.
8. For applications on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August in any year, the subscription (but not the “one-off” joining fee) shall be reduced by 50%.
9. The appropriate subscription and one-off joining fee must be deposited with this application for membership form. Should the applicant not be accepted for membership, all monies so deposited will be refunded. After two days have expired after delivery of this application form and payment of the deposit, the applicant will be deemed to be a temporary member of the Club and (where applicable) Section until his/her application is approved or rejected.
10. A separate application form is required for each applicant, who must be proposed and seconded by existing senior members.
11. Club only subscription entitles any member to participate in the activities of the Snooker, Bridge, Petanque and Drama Sections. However, applicants wishing to join Bridge and/or Drama Sections can only be admitted to these Sections as and when vacancies exist.
